Child sexual abuse is no longer society's darkest secret. Adults who work with children can protect them from this horror. Stewards of Children's training educates adults to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to sexual abuse.

The Stewards of Children program is designed for child care teachers, directors and family child care providers.

In addition to the prevention portion of the training, this comprehensive program also incorporates all the fundamental mechanics necessary in creating organizational policies and procedures that keep children safe, such as the screening and monitoring of staff and volunteers. As we are aware, child care workers play a critical role in protecting children. Research supports that 42% of children who disclose sexual abuse tell a teacher. Child care workers who know the signs and the process of reporting can intervene and protect not only one child but countless others. Additionally, armed with this information child care workers will be far more prepared to communicate with parents around the issue of child sexual abuse, and how they can keep their children safe.

Because of the intense subject matter, it is recommended that teachers already have a basic child abuse class prior to taking this one.
